3. **OUTDOORS:** your daily exercise routines, nature, landscapes, Ross town centre, social distancing, walking with the family, dog or cat
4. **BAKING:** your lockdown triumphs (or disasters)
5. **ART:** any adult or children's indoor/outdoor projects including paintings, sewing, sketches, fashion items, a garden installation or anything creative.

Winning entries in each category will be reprinted and framed in A3 format – initially displayed online in conjunction with the St Mary's Lockdown Exhibition and at a later date at a local public exhibition to be confirmed post lockdown.
